- I. Call meeting to order: Amana Colonies Land Use District Historic Preservation Commission Jeff Conquest called the meeting to Order at 6:31 P.M. Present in person: Betsy Momany, Jeff Conquest and Nathan Smith. Absent: Alex Momany and Stephen Michalec.

 - a. 2025-078 Jack Hoehnle /733 47th Ave./ HP-R/ Replace rotten portions of window frames and doors with all aluminum trim in white. Install new 6" aluminum round gutters in white and 4" downspouts. Replace soffits and fascia with aluminum white. B. Momany made a motion to approve the application as presented with the downspouts and gutters to be galvanized. 2nd by Conquest. Motion passed unanimously.
 - b. 2025-077 Jeff Yates /505 45th Ave. /HP-R/ Replace 1 window on front of home that matches the current 33X40 window. Smith made a motion to approve the application as presented. 2nd by B. Momany. Motion passed unanimously.
