 - a. 2026-029 Brad Zuber /5203 D St. East Amana/ HP-R/ Add 7'X12' lean-to onto existing one.
 - b. 2026-030 Amana Society Inc. /920 48th Ave./ HP-I/ Paint exterior of the "red shed" building back to its original color of red.
 - c. 2026-033 Brad & Shirley Daggy /1111 26th Ave. Middle/ HP-R/ Install LP smart side lap siding (4.5" reveal) on the wood framed portion of house & garage in color Wicker Rocker. Replace 10 windows with vinyl double hung in white. 9/6 (4) 29 1/2" X 58" 1/2. 6/6 (6) 29 1/2" X 48". Paint exterior trim color green sprout. Remove Cupola on garage. Tuckpoint damaged mortar.
 - d. 2026-034 Brad & Shirley Daggy /609 7th Ave. West Amana/ HP-C/ Replace damaged or missing board & batten siding. Enclose the lower stable section on the south side. Paint the exterior light gray. Install 6" 1/2 round gutters on the north side of barn.
 - e. 2026-035 The Egg Basket, LLC /4515 F St. Amana/ HP-C/ Remove flat roof rubber membrane (5 sections) and replace with rolled roofing shingles material. Remove wood deck and replace with treated wood decking (2X4) with cedar railing. Remove vertical cedar siding and replace with new vertical cedar siding. Replace 54" X 60" window with 9/6 vinyl replacement. Replace K style gutters & down spouts with 1/2 round galvanized gutters & down spouts.
